

CIRCULAR

Sub:- Compassionate appointment to the dependants of Deceased/ invalidated employees.

Ref: 1) Ministry of Shipping Lr No. C-13019/21/2011-PE-II dated 13-12-2011

2) Resolution No.133 dated 23-12-2011 of the Board of Trustees of Cochin Port Trust

A scheme for appointment of dependants of deceased/ medically invalidated employees on compassionate grounds is in vogue in Cochin Port Trust. The scheme was being implemented in Cochin Port Trust not strictly as per the Government of India guidelines.

Cochin Port Trust has received a direction from the Ministry of Shipping as per the reference first cited to follow the guidelines of the Government of India on this subject strictly.

The Board of Trustees of Cochin Port Trust considered the matter, and vide the reference second cited above, has resolved to discontinue the existing system of maintaining the waiting list indefinitely, as it was not as per Government Rules, and to run the scheme for appointment of dependants of deceased/ medically invalidated employees on compassionate grounds strictly according to Government of India guidelines. It was also resolved to do recruitments under the scheme only as per recruitment rules to posts and only in operational sectors of the Port.

Hence, the following guidelines are issued to regulate hereafter the implementation of the compassionate appointment scheme in Cochin Port Trust:-

i. Compassionate appointments may be made upto a maximum of 5% of the vacancies falling under direct recruitment quota in any Group C or D post in operational sectors of the Port.

ii. Only dependants of an employee dying in harness leaving his family in penury and without any means of livelihood may be appointed on compassionate ground.

iii. Offering compassionate appointment as a matter of course irrespective of the financial condition of the family of the deceased or medically retired Govt. servant will no longer be done as it is legally impermissible.



A candidate's name can be kept under consideration for compassionate appointment only for the

A committee with Secretary as Chairman and Traffic Manager and Financial Advisor & Chief Accounts Officer as members and Sr Welfare Officer as coordinator, will review the penurious conditions of the applicant at the end of the first and second year. After three years if compassionate appointment is not possible, his case will be finally closed and will not be considered again. The very fact that the family has been able to manage somehow all these years should normally be taken as adequate proof that the family had some dependable means of subsistence.

vi. Only dependants of deceased/medically invalidated employees strictly fulfilling the conditions as per the Govt. Rules will be considered under the scheme bereafter.

vii. Such appointments shall be subject to their fulfilling the qualifications as per recruitment rules.

viii. Recruitments under the scheme shall be only to posts in the operational sectors of the Port where there is no ban on recruitment.

ix. The dependant shall complete the registration process within three months from the date of demise/invalidation of the employee and the period of 3 years will be reckoned from the date of registration.

x. If the ward is below 18 years of age at the time of death/invalidation of the employee and if he/she alone is available for employment, the registration process should be completed within three months as mentioned above and he/she should apply as soon as he/she attains 18 years.

All concerned are requested to note for guidance, information and action accordingly.
