CIRCULAR

Sub : Cochin Port Employees Voluntary Retirement Scheme, 1992.

Ref : Ministry of Shipping's letter No. LB/16016/4/98-L.II dated 22.07.2003.

It has been decided to re-open the Special Voluntary Retirement Scheme, 1992 for a period of three months from 01.08.2003. The salient features of the Scheme to be implemented this time are highlighted hereunder :-

SALIENT FEATURES :

- a) The Scheme shall apply to all classes of regular employees viz., Class I to Class IV who have completed 10 years of service under the Board or reached 40 years of age.
- b) Voluntary Retirement cannot be claimed by an employee as a matter of right. The Authority reserves the right to accept or reject any application.
- c) An employee in whose case any disciplinary proceeding is pending or is contemplated will not be considered under the Scheme.
- d) No claim of the dependents of the employees going on Voluntary Retirement for any compassionate appointment under the Cochin Port Trust Board will be entertained.
- e) Employees retired under this Scheme will not be eligible for re-employment under the Board.
- f) All posts falling vacant as a result of Voluntary Retirement Scheme will be abolished and will not be eligible for revival in any case nor will be accounted for the purpose of computation of any matching savings while creating posts.
- g) Voluntary Retirement Scheme shall be given only to those employees who have been identified and recognized as 'surplus', based on a study conducted by the Departments, and is beneficial to the Port in terms of net savings but will not be given to persons who are doing essential functions.
- h) No Voluntary Retirement Scheme will be given to employees who have a residual service of less than 5 years.

BENEFITS :

An employee whose Voluntary Retirement is accepted will be eligible for the following payments :-

- a) The balance in his/ her Provident Fund Account payable as per the GPF/ CPF Regulations applicable to him/ her.

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- b) Cash equivalent of accumulated Earned Leave as per the CPTE (Leave) Regulations, 1978 as if he/ she retired under the normal rules of retirement.
- c) Gratuity under the provisions of the CCS (Pension) Rules or under the payment of Gratuity Act, 1972, whichever is beneficial.
- d) Pension as per the CCS (Pension) Rules for those who have opted for pension and for those who have opted for CPF, the benefits as applicable to them.

SPECIAL BENEFITS :

a) Ex-gratia payment : In addition, an employee whose request for Voluntary Retirement is accepted would also be entitled to an ex-gratia payment equivalent to 1-1/2 months emoluments for each completed year of service or the emoluments that would have become payable for the balance months of service left, whichever is less.

Emoluments for the purpose of calculating Ex-gratia payment include pay and Dearness Allowance but do not include HRA, CCA/ Port Allowance and any other Allowances.

For the purpose of calculation of Special Benefits only completed year of service is to be taken as completed year. Service of less than one year will be ignored.

b) Travel After Retirement : The employee and his/ her family would also be entitled to travel by the entitled class to the place where he/ she intends to settling down. The entitlement includes transportation, cost of personal effects as may be admissible in the case of superannuation/ retirement.

Those who wish to go on Voluntary Retirement under the Scheme shall apply for the same on or before 31.10.2003.

CIRCULAR

Sub: Cochin Port Employees Voluntary Retirement Scheme, 1992

The Cochin Port Employees Voluntary Retirement Scheme, 1992 has been put into operation till 31.3.2001 vide this office Circular of even number dated 13.2.2001.

The salient features of the Scheme and the benefits which employees can avail under the Scheme are as follows:

SALIENT FEATURES:

- a) The Scheme shall apply to all classes of regular employees viz. Class I to Class IV who have completed 10 years of service under the Board or completed 40 years of age.
- b) Voluntary Retirement cannot be claimed by any employee as a matter of right. The Authority Competent will have the right not to grant voluntary retirement for reasons to be recorded in writing.
- c) An employee in whose case any disciplinary proceedings is pending or is contemplated will not be considered under the Scheme until the disposal of the proceedings.
- d) No claim of the dependents of the employees going on Voluntary Retirement for any compassionate appointment under the Cochin Port Trust Board will be entertained.
- e) Employees retired under this Scheme will not be eligible for re-employment under the Board.

BENEFITS:

An employee whose Voluntary Retirement is accepted will be eligible for the following payments.

- a) the balance in his/her Provident Fund Account payable as per the GPF/CPF Regulations applicable to him/her.
- b) Cash equivalent of accumulated Earned Leave as per the CPTe (Leave) Regulations, 1978 as if he/she retires under the normal rules of retirement.

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- c) Gratuity under the provisions of the CCS (Pension) Rules or under the payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 whichever is beneficial to the employee.
- d) Pension as per the CCS (Pension) Rules for those who have opted for pension and for those who have opted for CPF, the benefits as applicable to them.

SPECIAL BENEFITS:

a) **Ex-gratia payment:** In addition, an employee whose request for Voluntary Retirement is accepted would also be entitled to an ex-gratia payment equivalent to 1-1/2 months emoluments for each completed year of service or the emoluments that would have become payable for the balance months of service left whichever is less.

Emoluments for the purpose of calculating Ex-gratia payment include pay and all kinds of Dearness Allowance but do not include HRA, CCA/Port Allowance and all other allowances.

For the purpose of calculation of Special Benefits only completed year of service is to be taken as completed year. Service of less than one year will be ignored.

b) **Travel After Retirement:** The employee and his/her family would also be entitled to travel by the entitled class to the place where he/she intends to settling down. The entitlement includes transportation, cost of personal effects as may be admissible in the case of superannuation/retirement.

Those who wish to go on Voluntary Retirement under the Scheme shall apply for the same on or before 31.3.2001.
